#### Christmas 2016

Try as you might, it will now be impossible to ignore the fact that Christmas is nearly upon us! The next 2 weeks are going to be incredibly busy so we thought a few reminders might be useful:

## **PFA Christmas Fayre**

We look forward to seeing you all at the PFA Christmas Fayre which starts at 3pm in the village hall on **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> December**. See the posters for more details. Please remember to return your slip and pay on Parentpay if you want to reserve your child's handicrafts.



## MAT Christingle

This takes place on **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> December** for years 3,4,5 and 6. If you have not already, we would be very grateful if you could return the permission slip asap. You will also have received a candle box in which we would be very grateful if you could place any monetary donations for the Children's Society (envelopes are also available from the school office). These should be returned to school by 6<sup>th</sup> December. Parents are very welcome to come to the Christingle event which takes place in Truro Cathedral at 10.00am. There are no tickets and seats will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Years 3-6 from each of our five MAT schools will be contributing towards the service.



#### Christmas Play

Our Nursery, Reception, Year 1, 2 and 3 children will perform their Christmas play, "The Christmas Farm" on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> December. There will be two

performances; one at 1.30pm and one at 6.30pm. There is no charge for the performances but donations on the door would be gratefully



received. To enable as many parents/carers to attend whilst maintaining safe numbers in the village hall spaces are limited to 2 places per family per performance. Bookings can be made at: www.veryan.parentseveningsystem.co.uk (This system will produce a list of attendees so no physical tickets will be needed).

After the play we are hoping a few of our younger instrumentalists will also perform with us along with Pendower class who, will be doing their first ever recorder performance (many thanks to Karen Green for all of her hard work and support with this).

After the afternoon performance, the children will be taken back to school to get changed. They will then be taken onto the playground to be dismissed in the usual way (this might be a bit earlier than usual for those children whose parents are there). We would like Nursery-Year 3 children to return to school at 6pm via the front door so that we can get them dressed and ready for the evening performance. Again, after the performance, they will be taken back to school to get changed and then dismissed from the playground. Whilst parents are waiting for children to get ready, we would be incredibly grateful for any help in putting the chairs and staging away as we have to clear the hall ready for the next day when it is being used again.

We know that the Christmas play is a very special and memorable occasion (hopefully for all the right reasons!). We would therefore like to give parents the



opportunity to take photos and/or films. This does depend very much on whether or not there are some parents who would prefer this not to happen and we completely understand if there are some of you that would prefer not.

If you do NOT want any photos/films, please inform Mrs Allan before Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> December. If no one objects and photos/films are allowed, we





must stipulate that **NO footage must be uploaded to social media.** 



#### Pantomime

The PFA have kindly funded a trip to the pantomime, to take place on **Monday 12**<sup>th</sup> **December**. The children will have an early lunch at 11.45pm so that they are ready to leave on the coach at 12.55pm. The coach will return to school at approximately 6.00pm and children will be dismissed from the playground as usual.

Please make sure you have returned your permission slip and ice cream/ice lolly order for your child by <u>Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December</u>. Ice creams are  $\pounds 2.25$  and ice lollies are  $\pounds 1.50$ . These need to be ordered beforehand, they will not be available to purchase on the day. We have also asked for a  $\pounds 3$  donation towards the coach. All of these payments can be made on your Parentpay account.

## **Christmas Concert**

This takes place on **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December** in the Church at 6pm. All are welcome. During this there will be readings and carols and each class will perform a song. There will also be some musical performances from Key Stage 2 instrumentalists.

## **Christmas Lunch**

their lunch by <u>Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December</u> so that Donna can make sure she has ordered sufficient food.
