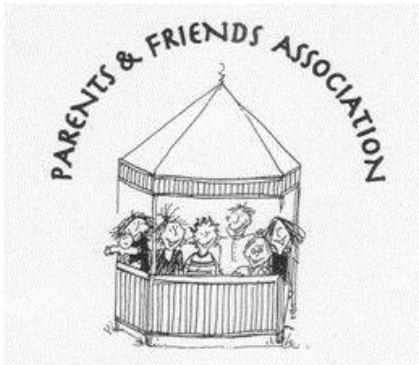




Veryan Primary School News
