There will be a transition meeting on Monday 17th October in Kiberick class for year 6 parents and children. Members of staff and ex Veryan pupils from The Roseland will come down to talk to you about the transition and answer any questions you might have. This is a very useful meeting to attend and helps to reassure children who might be feeling a little anxious.
