Congratulations to Parents!

I want to congratulate you all and say a big thank you for working so hard to improve our attendance.



At the end of the Spring term, the whole school's attendance was 94.19%. It is now 95.1% and edging back towards the national average of 96.1%.

There is still a little work to do but, thanks to your help, we are heading in the right direction. At the end of the Spring term we also had 8 children (16%) who were considered to be persistent

absentees due to their attendance being below 90%. There are now only 2 children (3%) who fall into this category. We do still have some unauthorised absences, but we are below the national average for this. At the end of the summer term I will write to you individually to inform you of your child(ren)'s attendance at the end of the year and high attendance will be rewarded in the final Collective Worship. I do understand that children get ill and you can do nothing about this and we would still ask that parents keep their children at home for 48 hours following any sickness or diarrhoea. But thank you for working with us to improve the current attendance and please keep it up until the end of the year!

Attendance this week

The expected average percentage attendance for a child is 96%.
