## Veryan Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS)

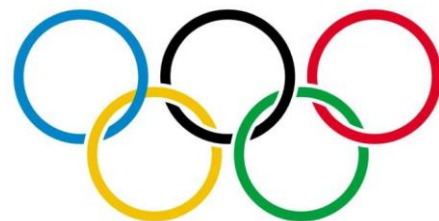
Mr Andrew Rickett will visit our school for the entire day on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July. During his visit, Mr Rickett will join us for Collective Worship, observe RE lessons, talk to children, governors and parents. The school will be judged in four areas:

- **How well does the school, through its distinctive Christian character, meet the needs of all learners?**
- **What is the impact of collective worship on the school community?**
- **How effective is Religious Education?**
- **How effective are the leadership and management of the school as a church school?**

As with Ofsted, the bar has been raised for SIAMS since our previous inspection in 2011 but I am sure Mr Rickett will recognise all of the good practise at Veryan school and will appreciate our wonderful children and their commitment to their learning.

In September there will also be a new ordering system on Parentpay. Parents/carers will be able to log onto their Parentpay account and in addition to making payments you will be able to select the meal choices with your children on the online form. These can then be checked on Iphones or printed out at home so that parents and children can check their order for the day.

If you have any problems accessing your Parentpay account please inform the school office. More information about the ordering system will be sent home in the new term.
