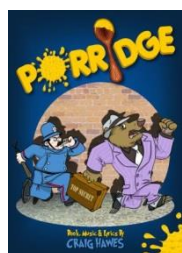
## June INSET week evaluation

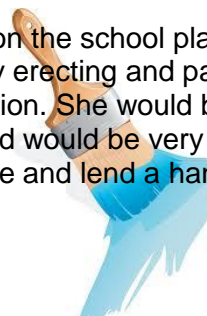


Does anyone have any of the following that we may be able to borrow for our production?
