#### **Parent Forum Feedback**

Thank you to the parents who attended the Veryan school parent forum last Friday afternoon. Mr Lees and Mrs Greenaway were also in attendance. Unfortunately Mrs Michell was not able to attend due to being on a course. A wide ranging and worthwhile discussion was held which covered the following points:

- 1. **School leadership** a parent asked if the current arrangement of leadership would continue after Christmas. Mr Lees said that the Trust Board would be deciding this very shortly and parents would be informed soon afterwards.
- 2. The immersive curriculum a long discussion took place about the teaching and learning in subjects other than Maths and English. Mr Lees explained the idea of the immersive curriculum that Veryan School will be undertaking from January 2017; The children will study topics that excite and interest them. We will ensure that they are taught the key skills and knowledge from the national curriculum. We will tell parents more about this later this term.

- 3. Thanks to Mrs Allan parents wanted us to thank Mrs Allan for all her hard work and support for parents. She always has a smiling face and has the patience of a saint!
- 4. Parentpay and online clubs booking although parents were in total support of the move toward online payments and bookings, they had some serious concerns about the website design for the sites we use. They are 'clunky' and not user friendly. One parent with expert knowledge has agreed to supply Mr Lees with some helpful observations about the sites that he has promised to take back to the trust's central team. There is further clarification on this at the end of this newsletter.\*
- 5. Children who travel in the taxi a parent asked if we could ensure that the younger children who travel in the taxi could be helped to bring home relevant paperwork and reading books. They were also concerned that reading books do not always get changed regularly enough. Mrs Greenaway said that she would follow up on this concern.
- 6. Christmas events parents asked for clarification on the Christmas events. Mrs Greenaway outlined these: 7th December at 1.30 and 6.30 will be the Year Nursery to Year 3 Christmas production - 'The Christmas Farm.'

The MAT Christingle takes place at Truro Cathedral on Tuesday 6th December at 10am and parents are very welcome to attend. The Christmas Carol Service will be in church on 13<sup>th</sup> December at 6.30 pm. Details on all of these events will follow shortly.

#### **SEND 0 to 25** Knowing where we are, moving forward together

Different people and groups have a range of experiences and views about what it means to live in Cornwall and have special educational needs and/or disability (SEND), to have a family member with SEND or to work with children and young people with SEND. Together we can draw together a shared understanding of SEND in Cornwall and have a clear view of what needs to happen next.

Every part of the country has to have a Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA), evidence about what life is like. Cornwall Council wants to share this, and some broader SEND information, with a wide range of people so we can identify what is important to keep the same or to change in the future.
