As part of the Inspection of Cornwall Council local area's effectiveness in identifying and meeting the needs of, and improving outcomes for, children and young people who have special educational needs and/or disabilities from 3 July- 7 July 2017, Ofsted will host an online webinar to allow parents and carers to contribute. The webinar will take place at **1.30 pm on Friday, 30 June 2017**. It will be led by the lead inspector, Nigel Evans HMI, who will ask parents and carers about their views and experiences on how effectively Cornwall Council is fulfilling the above responsibilities.

School transport – pedestrian routes assessment update from Cornwall Council:

We are continuing to assess routes to school to determine their suitability for pedestrians, either as a direct result of concerns raised by a parent/carer or through a reassessment programme of previously assessed routes.

A full list of all routes which have been assessed and classified as unsuitable walking routes since April 2016, as well as details of the assessment policy, can be found on the Council's website at the link below.

Where a pupil's route to your school would require them to walk on a route which has been classified by the Council as unsuitable for



pedestrian use, he or she will be eligible for transport free of charge if they:

- attend your school as their nearest or designated school (or were allocated a place as it was the nearest school with room);
- live within walking distance (up to two miles for children in Reception to Year 3, three miles for Years 4 to 11).

If you believe your child may be eligible for transport on this basis, please complete a pupil transport application form, which can be found at the link below.
