Year 1 Phonics

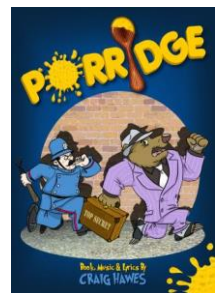


Mrs Greenaway will hold another phonics meeting for those parents who were unable to attend on Tuesday afternoon.

Soccer Roadshow - Our Football Roadshows are age and football specific with the emphasis on fun, enjoyment and development. Roadshows are held at a variety of venues including schools, clubs, leisure centres, and community centres. All roadshows are held at 10.00am and last for 2 hours.

Try This - Try This football sessions are aimed at three- to five-year-olds, who are experiencing their first taste of a structured football session. The sessions are run by a variety of coaches, all of whom are experienced in working with young children. The emphasis is to improve the children's listening and concentration skills whilst working on balance and co-ordination. This children can develop in a safe and fun environment over the duration of the session.

Multi-Sports Day - An opportunity to try a number of other sports in one day including football, hockey, netball, tag rugby, golf and a number of other activities all run by qualified coaches.

PAKS Disability - A half-day of football and team activities in an inclusive, confidence environment. The day is targeted at children with any impairment, learning difficulty or disability.
