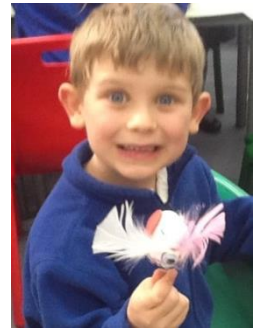
Thank you to Mrs Hawkins for driving the minibus and accompanying the children along with Miss Rogers – both of whom were very proud of the
