• Nasal immunisations

On Monday 16th October from 8:45-11am the immunisation team from Kernow Health will be in school to administer the nasal flu programme to those children from Reception-Year 4 who have consented to receive the nasal vaccine.

Please can we remind parents that the guidance leaflet sent home states that: "Children should not have the nasal vaccine if they: are currently wheezy or have been wheezy in the past three

days (vaccination should be delayed until at least three days after the wheezing has stopped).

If you think this applies to your child please inform Mrs Allan in the school office on Monday morning prior to the vaccine administration.
