I am writing to inform you about the Relationship, Health and Sex Education (RHSE) that the Y1 – Y6 children will take part in during the latter part of the week beginning 12th July, as part of their Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education.

The National Curriculum guidelines as to what should be taught at this stage and stage of development are outlined overleaf.

We recognised that RHSE can cause some parents concern. Please be assured that lessons will be taught sensitively and respectfully. To ensure we deliver the lesson at the right level for each individual child, we will split the groups with Mrs Cartwright predominantly teaching the Y5 & 6 children, Miss Blayney teaching the Y3 & 4 children and Miss Goodall will lead the Year 1 & 2 children in their lesson.

All parents have the right to withdraw their child from these lessons – should you wish to do so, please speak to Ms Jarrett by the end of the school day on Tuesday 13th July. However, we hope you feel this is an important part of the education of your children and a point best delivered in a partnership of trust between home and school.
