

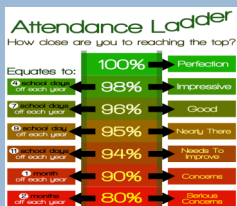

Impetigo warning

We have had cases of impetigo reported in school—this is a highly contagious skin condition but is not usually serious and with treatment gets better in 7-10 days. Impetigo starts with red sores or blisters which burst and leave crusty brown patches.

Infected persons should stay home until the lesions are crusted/healed or 48 hours after starting antibiotic treatment.

Tuesday 25th June - Veryan School Sports Day (weather permitting!)
