Year 6 parents/carers and pupils—transition meeting


You are invited to school on Monday 10th June to attend a meeting with Maggie McWilliams for a transition meeting for the Roseland Academy.


Ms Flack has 2 Maxi Cosi Priori car seats (9-18kg) available free of charge to anyone who can make use of them.
