



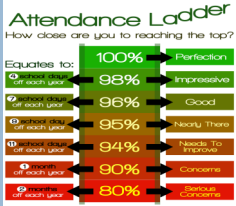

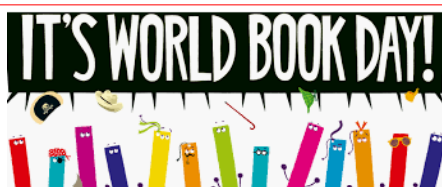

## WHAT TO WEAR?

On first arrival there will be some forms to fill out and then your child will be registered and on our system!

WK 5 (16<sup>th</sup>/05): Warm Up Game, Circuit of Activities, Cool Down Activity

WK 6 (23<sup>rd</sup>/05): Games and Matches!
