Your glittering host will guide you through an evening of games and activities designed to test students' knowledge on all things sustainable, hone their teamwork skills, and brush up their observational prowess. It's fast loud and sometimes a bit messy,

How long? 2 hours

Who? Years 4 – 11

Where? Inside the Core building

Children will:

- Learn new and slightly random facts around nature and sustainability
- Build things
- Take part in team games
- Work together to complete a giant Treasure hunt

What happens?

Students will divide into teams and take part in alternate question and activity rounds testing their general knowledge and their ability to think on their feet.

The session ends with a giant treasure hunt which sends the students to the hidden depths of the Core building to find clues, answer riddles and collect letters.

It's all about the big picture, sustainability and your role in the story but in a light hearted and interactive way. The aim of the workshop is to spend the evening doing something constructive, informative and a bit silly.
