It was clear from the meeting that parents are keen to keep the current open door policy that we have at Veryan and staff are also keen to maintain the good teacher-parent communication. However, it is also apparent that as the teaching/leadership structure changes that we may need to re-evaluate the way parents and teachers communicate and share day to day information.

As you will know we always try to make teachers available to meet and greet on the playground in the morning and at the end of the day and parents can pass messages to the teacher or TA at this time. However, there are also discussions that take longer and require more in-depth conversation. These are important conversations, but our priority must be to all of our children and settling them into their morning routines in the classroom to begin their learning. Therefore, going forward, we ask that if you need to talk to a teacher or school leader then an appointment is made via Mrs Allan in the school office and we will make ourselves available as much as possible without interrupting the children's valuable lesson time.

Mrs Allan is more than happy to pass on messages received by parents verbally, or via email—whether these are minor matters e.g. lost equipment, or more serious matters. Teachers and leaders can then consider the problem and make contact directly with parents either face-face, over the phone or via email whichever is most appropriate and at a mutually convenient time.


