Attendance Expected average attendance for a child is 96%. Our attendance for last week was 97.41%



The Government have stated that the national expectation for attendance is 96.1% and any pupil falling below this must be closely monitored by the school. Pupils who arrive after registration are registered as 'late' and this impacts on their attendance percentage. Please note that each day is made up of two attendance sessions - AM and PM.

Pupils who register below 93% attendance are categorised as 'persistent absentees' and we have a legal responsibility to make these pupils known to the Education Welfare Office (EWO) who monitors the school's attendance.



Around half term we will send home letters to keep you updated with your child's attendance this autumn term. We fully appreciate that children fall ill and certainly do not expect you to drag your child to school when they are unwell! However, we would encourage parents to please try to make general appointments during holiday time or outside of school hours and to take holiday outside of term time.
