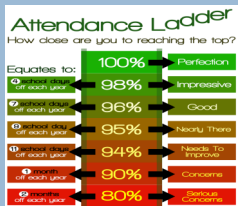

Our year 5 and 6 children have been taking part in bowling at Veryan Bowls Club on Monday afternoons.



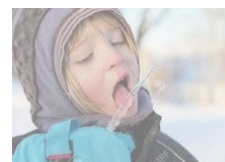
