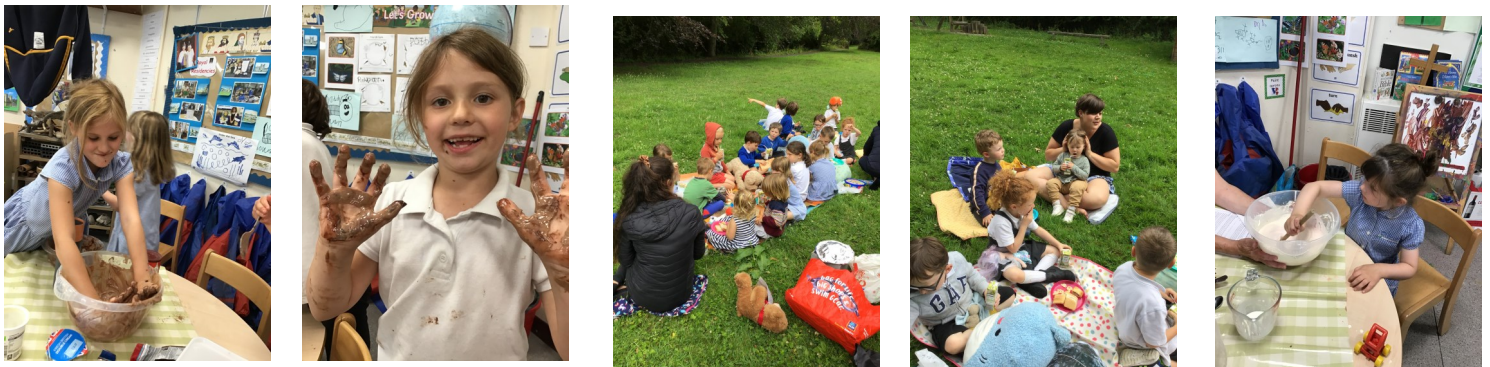

## Free School Meals

If you think you may be eligible for Free School Meals the criteria and link you will need to follow are below. Not only would your child receive free meals but this enables the school to access additional funding. If you would apply by post please contact the office for a paper application form.

### Free school meals eligibility criteria if you receive benefits

A child is eligible for free school meals if their parent/carer (or the child themselves) receives any of the following benefits:

Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).

Income Support (IS)

Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance

Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance

Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190

Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)

Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Supports

If you are claiming the benefits listed below you are not eligible for free school meals. This is regardless of what other benefits/credits are being claimed.

Working Tax Credit

Contribution-Based Job Seeker's Allowance and/or Contribution-Based Employment and Support Allowance

Dear Colleague,

We are currently in the process of implementing a new administration system for September, which will change how things work with our Service Level Agreements.

- 2) We will assume any existing Curriculum Support, School Funded\* Whole Class Lessons or School Ensembles will continue as per this term/academic year unless you give the normal 6 week notice to cancel.  
(\*First Access and other Projects charged to you by CMST but funded by ASONE will be dealt with separately.)

We will inform you of the new process for requesting any new delivery for curriculum support etc once the system has been implemented. To that end, please would you complete [this short form](#) to advise us of the best contact person..
