Message from Ms Jarrett

Dear parents and carers,

I hope you have had a good week and perhaps enjoyed a little more freedom since Wednesday? In school we have been busy making Christmas preparations and getting out and about at the Wild Tribe field. As you know, our outdoor learning has been a big focus this term and we are delighted to begin extending this to a 'Beach School!' Our aim is to begin a weekly trip to the beach for each class from January. We are trying to procure one of the MAT minibuses to help transport the children to and from the beach; the minibus will carry around 15 children, so we will also need support with transport and this is where I hope we can extend a plea to all our families and friends of the school and gather a group of volunteers who would be willing to offer regular help in transporting the children to and from the beach and/or help supervise the children whilst the lessons takes place.

We are also trying to ascertain how and where we may be able to park the minibus so as not to upset any of our local residents, but to enable us easy access and keep the bus based with us at Veryan so we can make full use of it as often as we can. If anyone has any contacts or ideas for storing the minibus we would welcome any suggestions or help finding a solution.

We are very excited to begin this new venture and are sure it will benefit all our children and hopefully encourage new families to consider Veryan Primary as their first school of choice.


Our whole school attendance last week was:

They also considered rock towers that they have seen on the beach and created a natural piece of art inspired by what they'd seen.














Some of them shot very high into the air!!
